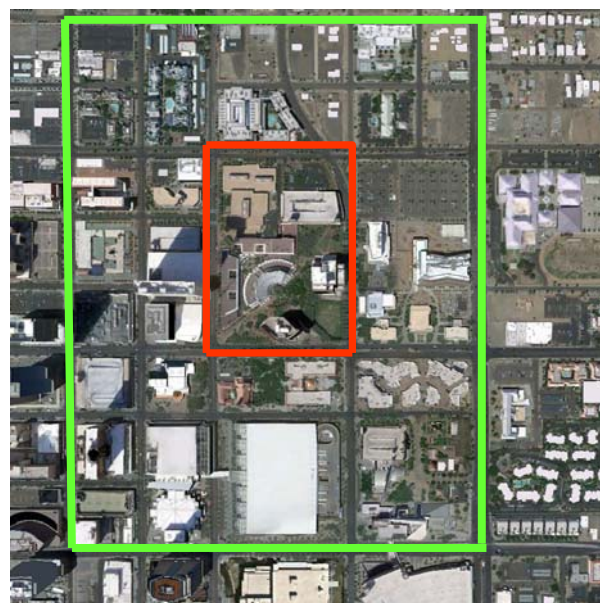
(Area bounded by 5th & 7th Streets, from Van Buren to Fillmore.)
