

# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

## 1. WHERE IS IT? WHEN IS IT? WHAT IS IT?

Zombie Walk is an annual gathering of zombies (and humans) that takes place on the last Saturday before Halloween in Heritage and Science Park in Downtown Phoenix. The all-day festival (2-11 p.m.) includes live music, food and beverage vendors, Little Zombie Zone and, of course, the epic 1.5-mile walk through the heart of Phoenix's urban core.

## 2. HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

Zombie Walk is free to attend but in the spirit of community building we are asking attendees to make a donation to St. Mary's Food Bank as we attempt to raise 7 tons of non-perishable aid for the less fortunate. It's human food. You don't need it anyway.

## 3. WILL SOMEONE DO MY MAKEUP FOR ME?
